Discussion:

There are no major changes to the 2021 operating budget. Staff continue to maintain 22 different parks, 8 sports fields, 7 trails, and many Beach accesses in addition to Whitechurch Hall, Ripley Library, Ripley Medical Centre and Day Care, Lucknow Library and Theatre, and Municipal office.

2020 Parks and other Facilities projects completed include the following:

- Ripley Library Carpeting and Roof replaced
- Medical Centre Windows replaced
- installation of gates baseline road walking Trail (old road allowance)
- Whitechurch Hall Community consultation completed

Treasurer's Comments:

The hiring of summer students in 2020 was delayed due to the pandemic. We also had savings from lining ball diamonds and soccer fields, as these activities did not take place.

For 2021, we have estimated a "normal" operating season. Minimum wage increased effective October 1, 2020 which also has an impact on the maintenance budget for parks.
