### **Background:**

The ten year capital forecast is attached for Council's review.

### **Discussion:**

This is a preview of the various projects that staff are considering for the next ten years. Many of the projects are still in the preliminary planning stages and the budget estimates reflect that, particularly in the later years. The purpose of the document is to share with Council, the projects that staff are working towards. It is important to note that just because a project is in the plan, it does not necessarily mean it will proceed on that timeline, or at all. You will also note that there are not a lot of confirmed funding sources. Those tend to fall into place as we near the anticipated project implementation dates and we will always try to prepare as much as possible with grant application and/or use of reserves.

### **Financial Impacts:**

The ten year capital forecast contains preliminary budget estimates for projects that will be refined as we get closer to implementation. It may also be necessary to defer particular projects based on available funding, therefore the plan should not be considered as a commitment to undertake projects.
