	The Township fleet will now consist of seven tandem plow trucks and one single axle plow truck in order to maintain our Level of Service. Therefore, the 2021 truck has now replaced our 2005 Sterling truck. Township staff recommend ordering a 2022 tandem plow in 2021 that will replace our 2006 Sterling truck.		
Pick-up Trucks \$135,000	With the evolving pandemic situation and the need for the purchase of a single axle plow truck, Township staff decided to not purchase any pick-up trucks in 2020.

	The 2011 Chevrolet truck that was transferred to the Fire Department will be replaced in 2021 and will be used by Community Services. Township staff are also looking into adding another pick-up to the Public Works fleet due to shortage of passenger vehicles in both the summer months when summer students are hired and in the winter when seasonal staff are now required.		
	Township staff are also planning to attempt to sell the 2019 F-150 currently driven by the Director of Public Works for the same \$40,000 price it was purchased for in 2019. If it is sold, then a third pick-up will be purchased. If we are unsuccessful, then only two pick-up trucks will be purchased in 2021.		
Grader Painting	With the increased expenditures related to winter maintenance equipment, Township staff decided to defer
