Summary of Events

By-Law Enforcement

There were four reports of camping on Township property. All parties that were located were informed that camping on Township property is prohibited.

Complaints were made regarding golf carts being driven in the Point Clark area and being parked near beach access points. Notices were placed on those golf carts to inform drivers that golf carts are prohibited on the roadways and on beach accesses.

Animal Control

Dogs running at large were an issue this month. Notices of violations were sent out to dog owners that permitted their dogs to run without supervision or not on a leash. One of dogs that was found running at large was taken to the Pound and later adopted out.

In separate occasions, calls were received regarding cats and kittens that were strays in an urban area. The local animal rescue contact information was given out to the callers.

A beehive that was situated in a residential area was requested to be relocated to an agricultural area. The property owner was very accommodating in granting that request.
