



With a background of newspaper, printing, literacy, and finally transport, Heinish Corner has significant historical roots in Ripley. A unifying theme of connectivity, wheel, or central hub applies, connecting the past with the present, residents with each other, and highlighting Ripley as a central gathering place within the Township of Huron Kinloss. Heinish Corner will be a place to gather, share, create memories and strengthen community identity.

Features will include a central gathering plaza with unobstructed walkways; low planting beds with seasonal flowering shrubs and perennials that contain the plaza, protect guests from surrounding traffic and maintain sight lines in and out of the plaza; a pergola for seating and shelter; and low decorative entrance fences to highlight and identify the entrance to the plaza from the main road intersection.
