Background:

The Community Services Department plans and implements programming and events throughout the calendar year including Summer Sports, minor baseball and soccer, the Wolf Cub Adventure Camp and the Ripley Food Art Craft Festival.

Discussion:

As of Monday, March 29th all ice rentals have been cancelled for the remainder of the season and ice removed. This decision was made in consultation with Public Health and recommended to Huron Bruce Minor Hockey and the Ripley Skating Club, as a result of the increased COVID19 cases in the area. Ice cancelled as a result of the pandemic will not be invoiced.

St. John's Ambulance are not running in-person Home Alone or Babysitter's Courses, however they are offering the Home Alone Course online. Staff have shared registration information on social media for this course and will offer when courses are available in person.

Summer Sports registration closed on March 31st. The Summer Sports Committee and staff are closely monitoring current Public Health measures and governing bodies Baseball Ontario and Ontario Soccer for next steps in the planning process for the season.

Registration continues for the Ripley Food Art Craft Festival and the Wolf Cub Adventure Camp. Staff are working with Public Health and surrounding municipalities to create procedures and safety plans for these programs and events.
