Background:

Fire Department/CEMC Administration

During the month of March, the following Fire and Emergency Services administrative tasks have been initiated, are on-going and/or have been completed.

- 1. All general administrative tasks with the day-to-day operations of the Fire Departments for the month have been completed.
- 2. The monthly activities for the Ripley-Huron and Lucknow & District Fire Departments are detailed below in the discussion section.
- 3. All Municipal Emergency Management Committee meetings have been conducted and the minutes have been recorded and filed.
- 4. Fire Chief/CEMC attended 2 Vaccine Task Force Meetings virtually
- 5. Vaccination Plan was implemented and all Fire and Emergency Service personnel seeking vaccination received their first dose in March 2021.
- 6. All Chiefs Quarterly Operational Planning Meeting was held at the Ripley-Huron Station in March.

- 7. On March 29th, the Fire Chief received confirmation from the OFMEM that we will be receiving a total of \$7,200.00 for our fire safety grant. Previously it was \$6,300.00. This will be used towards obtaining the training and certification of 16 members to the NFPA 1002 Driver/Operator Fire Pump standard, as indicated previously in Staff Report # 2021-03-09. This training course is scheduled for two weekends in April 2021.
- 8. The 2020 Emergency management Program Compliance letter was received by the Fire Chief and is attached for the Committees review.
