Background:

The Community Development Officer/Executive Assistant is providing an update on the Resident Attraction project.

Discussion:

The next step in the Resident Attraction project was to host a Realtor's and Developer's breakfast where we could showcase all the new developments taking place in Huron-Kinloss and also distribute the resident attraction booklets. Due to the evolving pandemic situation and the progress of the subdivision developments, staff is recommending a different approach to distributing the booklets this spring. We would prefer to contact the local Real Estate Agents and Brokerages to determine if they would like copies of the resident attraction booklets and deliver copies to them instead. We feel this route is more appropriate given the current circumstances and to ensure the booklets are available during the most suitable phase of subdivision development.

Staff will continue to monitor the progress of the subdivision development sales and resident attraction initiatives to determine if a Realtor's and Developer's breakfast is appropriate to host in the Fall. We will also be launching a marketing campaign around resident attraction once we have the social media pieces and video finalized, this will be scheduled for later this Spring.
