County of Bruce Municipal Hazardous & Special Waste Event Schedule

The County of Bruce 2021 Municipal Hazardous & Special Waste Events started May 1st.

Yard Waste Depots

At the Feb. 26, 2021 Budget meeting, Council directed staff to construct a yard waste disposal area at the Huron Landfill in addition to the existing site in Lucknow. At the April 7, 2021 Committee of the Whole meeting, Township Council authorized staff to proceed with the construction of the yard waste depot at the Huron Landfill on a time and materials basis.

Yard Waste Depots

The site on Havelock St. in Lucknow was opened for the season on April 8th.

The Huron Landfill site is currently under construction and is expected to be open to the public by mid-May.

The Municipal Hazardous & Special Waste Events are managed by the County of Bruce.

The construction and maintenance of the yard waste depots are included in the 2021 Operating Budget.
