Background:

The Cemetery Columbarium was installed in June of 2020.

The Mausoleum basement door had been vandalized several times in the last few years.

Discussion:

Since that date, the staff have sold six niches and the public has provided very positive feedback with the style, and location of the Columbarium. If anyone is interested in purchasing a final resting place, please contact Community Services department at 519-395-2909.

The mausoleum basement door has since been replaced including reframing the basement end wall and using a custom height door. The door is very secure now. We bring this forward for information purposes.

Financial Impacts:

The Cemetery mausoleum door was not included in the 2020 budget. The project was completed due to the building being not secure from vandals. The cost was \$5,500.
