Your email dated June 6, 2021 regarding the Boiler Beach Road Reconstruction project was discussed at the Township of Huron-Kinloss Committee of the Whole Meeting on July 5, 2021

Township staff are still in the process of gathering information that will be necessary in order to create a new Boiler Beach Road that provides enhanced safety for all users of the roadway while promoting active transportation. Our intent is to eventually receive comments from all stakeholders that will be affected by this project, however, the process in which these comments will be received has not been determined at this time.

We would like to take this opportunity to clarify that no decisions have been made regarding the location of multi-use lanes, parking facilities or traffic calming measures, other than that these components have been deemed to be an integral part of this project by both Township staff and Township Council.
