BY-LAW

2021- 85

Being a By-Law to provide for Drainage Works on the Bruce Beach Municipal Drain Phase 1

WHEREAS the requisite number of owners had petitioned the Council for The Township of Huron-Kinloss in accordance with the provisions of the *Drainage Act, R.S.O., 1990* requesting the following lands and roads be drained by a drainage works;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss has procured a report prepared by Headway Engineering and the report is attached and forms part of this by-law;

AND WHEREAS the estimated total project cost of the drainage works for the drain is \$1,015,000.00;

AND WHEREAS the Council is of the opinion that the drainage of the area is desirable;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss, pursuant to the *Drainage Act, R.S.O., 1990* enacts as follows:

- 1.0 That The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss Council hereby adopts the report dated July 8, 2021 and the drainage works as therein indicated and set forth is hereby authorized and shall be completed in accordance therewith.
- 2.0 The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss may borrow on the credit of the Corporation the amount necessary for construction of the drain works.
- 3.0 The Corporation will issue invoices for the amount borrowed less the total amount of:
 - a) Grants received under Section 85 of the Act;
 - b) Moneys paid under subsection 61(3) of the Act;
- 4.0 A special rate sufficient to redeem the total cost of the drainage works shall be levied upon the lands and roads, as noted on Schedule "A" attached hereto, to be collected.
- 5.0 All assessments will be payable as per the payment terms established by the municipality.
- 6.0 This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
- 7.0 This By-law may be cited as the "Bruce Beach Municipal Drain Phase 1 By-Law".
