Background:

The Court of Revision for the Bruce Beach-Phase 1 Municipal drain was held on August 9, 2021. The purpose of the Court of Revisions is to deal with appeals from members of the watershed that feel that they have been inappropriately assessed for the cost of the work.

There were two written appeals submitted by the deadline for submissions. No late appeals either written or verbal were accepted by the Court.

As a result, one comment was made by a member of the watershed concerning assessments. Any member of the watershed who has appealed to the Court and is dissatisfied with the result may appeal further to the Ontario Drainage Tribunal.

Discussion:

The Township has received three appeals that have been forwarded to the Tribunal.

- 3. David Brisbin, 111-2 Bruce Beach Road-Sec. 48 (the Clerk has requested confirmation from the appellant as Sec 48 is related to the Drainage report and the information provided speaks to a Sec 54 appeal)

The Township will be advised by the Tribunal when the appeals can be heard, and the appellants will be notified.

This is part of the due process of the Drainage Act to ensure fairness to any member of the watershed who is assessed for costs of a project.
