That the Township of Huron-Kinloss Committee of the Whole hereby approves Report Number DRAIN-2021-09-17 prepared by Grant Collins, Drainage Superintendent and approves the tender of A. G Hater Contracting LTD. in the amount of \$89,270.00 plus HST for the Robert MacDonald Municipal Drain 2021 AND FURTHER authorizes the appropriate By-law to come forward.

Background:

At the July 19, 2021 Township of Huron-Kinloss Council meeting, Council accepted the Robert MacDonald Municipal Drain 2021 Report. Tender packages were posted and emailed and mailed directly to several area drainage companies for their consideration. The tenders closed on August 12, 2021, at noon with two tenders being received.

Results as follows:

A.G Hater Contracting LTD \$89,270.00 plus HST
Robinson Farm Drainage Limited \$ 99,850.00 plus HST

Discussion:

Dietrich Engineering Limited reviewed the tenders and have recommended that the Township award the contract for construction to A.G. Hater Contracting LTD. for the tender price of \$89,270.00 plus HST.

The Engineer's estimate for the project was \$81,100.00 plus HST.
The start date is set to be on or before August 15, 2022, with a completion date on or before October 31, 2022.

Staff concurs with the recommendation of Dietrich Engineering and requests that the appropriate By-law come forward to allow the tender to be awarded and construction work commence following the appeal periods as outlined in the Drainage Act, R.S.O. 1990 as amended.

Financial Impacts:

All associated costs will be allocated to the property owners within the watershed.
