Background:

On January 1, 2019, amendments to the Police Services Act, 1990 came into force which mandated every municipality to prepare and adopt a community safety and well-being plan by January 1, 2021. The CSWBP was adopted by Township of Huron-Kinloss Council at their December 21, 2020 Council meeting.

Following in June 2021 the Township of Huron-Kinloss supported to continue the collaborative approach to implement the Plan and to make use of existing relationships with partnering organizations and to effectively sharing resources.

The County of Bruce and the County of Grey continue to facilitate the process and an Advisory Committee known as the Bruce-Grey Community Safety and Well-Being Advisory Committee has been established with Councillor Lillian Abbott and Clerk Emily Dance representing the Township.

Discussion:

A Second Engagement Survey was launched between April 1-May 20, 2021. 861 surveys were submitted for all of Bruce and Grey County. The raw data and coded comments have been received from the consultant. The coordinator will complete analysis, comparison and prepare a report that can be released publicly on the second engagement survey.

Assessment and establishment of CSWBP Action Tables is in progress. A working group has been formed with Poverty Task Force, Drug & Alcohol Strategy, and Homelessness Response Table to further explore risk priority indicators.

S.T.A.R (Situation Table for Acute Risk) refresh began on July 6, 2021. Between July 6 to September 7, STAR has facilitated 3 situations. The data collected on the situations is entered into the Risk Tracking Database (RTD) and will inform future discussion on priority setting by action tables and the advisory committee.

A Terms of Reference for a Crime Prevention Action Table has been drafted for the Crime Prevention risk priority area.
