Calls for Service of Note

- **Assault** - An investigation into a fight in Lucknow that resulted in significant injuries, has led to two counts of Aggravated Assault and two counts of Assault with a Weapon being laid.
- **Theft Over** – A number of thefts occurred that involved items over \$5000.00. They included the theft of tools – in one instance approximately \$15,000 worth of tools and in another case approximately \$8,000 worth of tools were stolen. In addition to this a theft occurred that involved approximately \$5,000 worth of fishing equipment being stolen.
- **Theft Over** – Work trailers were also targeted in this time period with a Utility Trailer and mower stolen as well as a trailer full of fencing boards taken.
- **Theft Over** – A great investigation by our Community Street Crimes Unit resulted in the recovery of a stolen lawn tractor valued at approximately \$30,000. Also recovered in this search warrant was a stolen snow machine. Two people were arrested and charged with Possession of Stolen Property.
- **Arson** – In August two fires were reported at partially constructed homes along Boiler Beach Road within a day of each other. One fire resulted in the total destruction of a home. The Fire Marshall was engaged and the investigation continues with our Major Crimes Unit.
- **Drugs** – In August our Community Street Crimes Unit assisted by our Tactical and Emergency Response Teams executed a drug warrant in Lucknow. Approximately \$5000.00 of Methamphetamine and Oxycodone were seized. In addition a stolen pickup truck and ATV were recovered. Four people were arrested and 23 charges laid.

Detachment Updates

- South Bruce OPP detachment welcomed three new recruits in June of 2021. PC Brittany Hymers, PC Jake Karley and PC Luke Zettler. All have been assigned to frontline platoons being coached and mentored by our experienced officers. We will welcome another recruit in September as well as three more in February 2022.
- South Bruce OPP also welcomed Detective Sergeant Kimberley Hogan. She was the successful candidate for the Major Crime Unit supervisory position. She joins us with a vast amount of experience from Huron County Major Crime Unit.
- In response to complaints regarding modified and noisy vehicles, officers have been provided with an educational package on what elements to look for in order to support a charge for these offences. A Focused Patrol was initiated for the summer months to focus on the enforcement of these vehicles.
- We have worked with Municipal Staff to provide the public with educational information around the Golf Car pilot rolled out on Sept 7th. A joint educational video is planned as well.
