Background:

The Community Services Department plans, implements and hosts programming and events such as the indoor Pickleball program, Parent, Senior & Tot skating, Spin Classes, Public Skating and the VON SMART Fitness program.

Discussion:

The Community Services Department have finalized and begun implementing the provincially mandated Vaccination Certificate Validation process at the Ripley-Huron Community Centre. Staff have now begun planning the start up of additional programming, such as indoor pickleball, parent, senior & tot skating, public skating and spin classes, with these processes in place. Along with the addition of Vaccination Certificate Validation, contact tracing and maximum capacity per space will continue to be followed for these programs.

Staff will be contacting the Pickleball group to gauge interest in continuing the program indoors in October. Pickleball runs on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. The Parent, Senior & Tot Skating program will begin on Monday, October 4th and run on Mondays and Fridays from 9:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. Public Skating will run on Saturdays from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., starting in mid-October. Staff are working on finalizing the Public Skating schedule and the department will be seeking sponsors for these skates. The VON SMART Fitness

program for Seniors will begin on Monday, October 4th and run on Mondays and Wednesdays from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. in the Auditorium.
