BY-LAW

2021-115

Being a By-Law to Dedicate Certain Lands as Part of the Public Highway
known as Melville Lane, in the Township of Huron-Kinloss

WHEREAS the Municipal Act S.O. 2001, c 25, Section 31 (2) confers that land may only become a highway by virtue of a by-law establishing the highway and not by the activities of the municipality or any other person in relation to the land.

AND WHEREAS, The Council for The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss acquired the lands described as Part 1 and Part 2 Plan 3R-10510 Part of Lot 3, Plan 100; Huron-Kinloss for Melville Lane Road Widening;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss enacts as follows:

- 1.0 THAT the lands described as Part 1 and Part 2 on Plan 3R-10510 Part of Lot 3, Plan 100 being all of PINS 33324-0252 and 33324-0251 all in LRO #3 (Bruce) are hereby dedicated as part of the public highway known as Melville Lane
- 3.0 This By-law shall come into force and effect upon its final passage.
- 4.0 This By-law may be cited as the "Road Dedication Melville Lane By-law"
