Being a By-Law to provide for Drainage Works on the

Clark Creek Municipal Drain, 2021

WHEREAS the requisite number of owners had petitioned the Council for The Township of Huron-Kinloss in accordance with the provisions of the *Drainage Act, R.S.O.,1990* requesting the following lands and roads be drained by a drainage works;

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss has procured a report prepared by K. Smart Associated Limited and the report is attached and forms part of this By-law;

WHEREAS the estimated total cost of constructing the drainage works for the drain is \$527,150;

WHEREAS the Council is of the opinion that the drainage of the area is desirable;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss, pursuant to the *Drainage Act, R.S.O., 1990* enacts as follows:

- 1.0 That The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss Council hereby adopts the report dated November 12, 2021 and the drainage works as therein indicated and set forth is hereby authorized and shall be completed in accordance therewith.
- 2.0 The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss may borrow on the credit of the Corporation the amount necessary for construction of the drain works.
- 3.0 The Corporation will issue invoices for the amount borrowed less the total amount of:
 - a) Grants received under Section 85 of the Act;
 - b) Moneys paid under subsection 61(3) of the Act;
- 4.0 A special rate sufficient to redeem the total cost of the drainage works shall be levied upon the lands and roads, as noted on Schedule "A" attached hereto, to be collected.
- 5.0 All assessments will be payable as per the payment terms established by the municipality.
- 6.0 This by-law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
- 7.0 This by-law may be cited as the "Clark Creek Municipal Drain, 2021 By-Law".
