By-Law Enforcement

Notices were provided to multiple residents regarding the depositing of snow and ice on roadways due to pushing snow across the road to clear driveways. This action can be quite dangerous to all drivers including snow plow operators and is in violation of the Huron-Kinloss Prohibition of Snow Piling on Roadways By-Law No. 2011-136.

Animal Control

A resident was issued a Notice of Violation when their dog left the property and aggressively approached a person walking by on the roadway.

Property Standards

This month there were four complaints related to trees which are dead, decayed or damaged on properties within the lakeshore area of the Township. The remaining two complaints were regarding buildings that have not been maintained.

Parking

There were complaints in relation to the restrictive winter parking on Township roadways and parking lots. Each complaint was investigated and warnings were issued when there was a violation.
