Dear Huron-Kinloss Council,

Starting last night I have tried multiple ways to get the attention of Huron-Kinloss to monitor and prepare for flooding of the Bruce Beach Municipal Drain, but to little avail and response. I have tried sending email to info@huronkinloss.com, and Grant Collins, I've telephoned Huron-Kinloss and Grant Collins. I've talked to a clerk at Public Works who assured me the problem was being handled, but it was not. I even called your Emergency Hotline and reported a flooding emergency.

This is the first attention to the problem we have received starting at 5:00 pm and the drain is now flooding, yet again, over Bruce Beach Rd and threatening properties.





There is an item on the agenda for tonight's council meeting regarding this problem. Please properly address the situation and make some clear statements that you will authorize and fund a full emergency mitigation of this flooding threat during construction of both Phase I and Phase II of the Bruce Beach Municipal Drain.
