Background:

As noted in staff report <u>CLK-2021-12-139</u> the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks released new regulations under the *Conservations Authorities Act.* These regulations change the relationship between municipal governments and conservation authorities (CAs) around the scope of the programs and services delivered.

The release of Ontario Regulation (O. Reg.) 687/21: Transition Plans and Agreements for the Programs and Services Under Section 21.1.2 of the Act outlines the requirement for conservation authorities to develop and deliver an inventory of programs and services to municipalities under its jurisdiction and to the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) by February 28, 2022.

The programs and services are to be categorized as mandatory or non-mandatory as outlined in Ontario Regulation 686/21: Mandatory Programs and Services

Discussion:

The inventory of programs and services from SVCA, MVCA and GSCA are attached for Council's review and have been circulated to Senior Staff.

Consultation on the inventory is to be conducted as soon as the inventory is received until December 31, 2023. Staff will collaborate with the CAs to bring a report to Council to begin discussions, acquire feedback on the inventory and provide the opportunity to address questions.
