Background:

Province of Ontario

On April 22, 2022, the Ontario government announced that the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health (OCMOH) will be maintaining existing masking requirements in select higher-risk indoor settings, as well as all remaining directives issued by the OCMOH in response to COVID-19, until June 11, 2022. This marks a change from the government's previous announcement of its intention to lift all remaining COVID-19 measures and directives effective April 27, 2022.

Masking requirements will remain in the following select indoor settings:

- Public transit
- Health care settings (e.g., hospitals, doctors' offices, clinics that provide health care services, laboratories, specimen collection centres, and home and community care)
- Long-term care homes
- Retirement homes
- Shelters and other congregate care settings that provide care and services to medically and socially vulnerable individuals
