Background:

2021 Landfill Monitoring Reports

In accordance with our Certificate of Approval, landfill monitoring reports are required to be submitted to the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks by March 31st on an annual basis.

Yard Waste Depots

The Township has two sites where residents can dispose of brush and yard waste. One location is on Havelock St. North in Lucknow, south of the Kinsmen Soccer Fields and the other location is east of the Huron Landfill entrance on Con. 6 E. They are open from April to October annually. The exact date of opening will vary from year to year depending on weather conditions.

Yard Waste Depots

The Lucknow site opened for the season on April 6th and the Huron Landfill site opened on April 27th. The Huron Landfill site was delayed due to the construction work required to restore the site and improve some of the drainage issues that we experienced last year.
