Background:

On April 28, 2022, the Clerk received a Petition for Drainage Works from John Yungblut, Director of Public Works to incorporate the Ripley Storm Drain as a municipal Drain within the Park Street Municipal Drain project.

Discussion:

On October 10, 2018, a request for improvement was submitted by David Brown of 1519201 Ont Inc to investigate obtaining an improved outlet for the Park Street Municipal Drain where proposed development is planned in the Village of Ripley.

Following on March 23, 2021, a request for improvement for the Railway Street Municipal Drain was submitted by Jeff Richardson to investigate enclosing the existing Railway Street Municipal Drain on their property in the Village of Ripley.

During the Engineer's preparation of the report, it was realized that the Ripley Storm Drain could be incorporated into the report which will allow for maintenance activities on private property.
