Summer Student Hires

Community Services has been advertising since February for Parks and Camp positions. Four additional resumes had been received for Parks, and one resume for camp. All students were interviewed. Brock Courtney was selected for the parks position and Ethan Glascott was selected for the Camp position.

The Point Clark Digital sign has bee in need of repair since March of 2022. The south facing sign is unreadable. Cox Signs have indicated a supply issue for parts and have assured us that when parts arrive the digital sign will be repaired.

Parks and Recreation Master Plan

PRC consulting has completed focus groups meetings, and has a visioning workshop scheduled for Tuesday July 12th, 2022.
