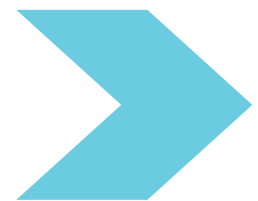
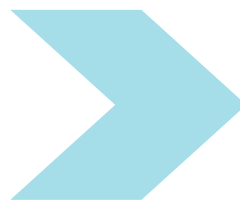
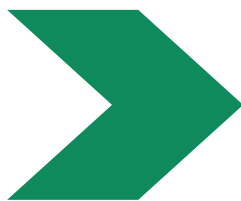

MAY 5 MEETING BASELINE CONDITIONS AND COMMUNITY GROWTH TARGETS

Prior to the completion and delivery of the municipal and NWMO-led studies, an overview of key information that applies in many of the study reports will be given to the CLC.

Information such as current demographics, defining the regional, local and core study areas, baseline growth expectations for South Bruce and the study areas, basic Project parameters and phases, and Project growth targets will be shared. This data informs most of the studies that will be shared over the next two years.

The presentation will be given by the South Bruce and NWMO study leads, Dave Rushton and Allan Webster, respectively.

GHD and *metroeconomics* consultants will also be present.

MAY 19 MEETING PROJECT WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

The Labour Baseline Study, Workforce Development Study and Local Hiring Effects Study and Strategy will be discussed at this special meeting.

Some of the presentation highlights will include Project labour demands such as in skilled trades and mining, indirect and induced employment demands, existing business demands, potential purpose and functions of the Centre of Expertise, including training and education opportunities and other information from these workforce related studies.

The presentation will be given by the South Bruce and NWMO study leads. Consultants and peer-reviewers that were involved in these three studies will also participate and address questions.
