RE: Science-based Research into the Deep Geological Repository for Nuclear Waste

The Township of Huron-Kinloss Council received your letter dated March 17, 2022, regarding residents having access to unbiased research into the impacts of a deep geological repository (DGR) in Bruce County and the request for financial support for the research.
