Recommendation:

That the Township of Huron-Kinloss Committee of the Whole hereby approves Report CLK2022-09-92 prepared by Kelly Lush, Deputy Clerk AND grants an exemption to the Noise By-Law for 337 Lake Range Drive, Point Clark from 11:00 p.m. Saturday, September 24, 2022 to 1:00 a.m. on Sunday, September 25, 2022 for a private wedding ceremony and reception AND FURTHER approves and exemption to the Noise By-Law for 17 Queen Street, Ripley on Saturday, September 24, 2022 for a fireworks display at dusk put on by the Ripley Agriculture Society for the Ripley Fall Fair SUBJECT to final approval from the Fire Chief.

Background:

Township of Huron-Kinloss By-Law No. 2005-101 as amended being the Noise Control By-Law outlines prohibitions of noise by time and place.

The By-law prohibits the production of amplified sound between the hours of 11:00 p.m. one day to 7:00 a.m. the next day (9:00 a.m. Sunday) and prohibits the detonation of fireworks except if in association with Canada Day or Victoria Day celebrations.

Council may by resolution grant an exemption to the Noise By-Law.

The Township has received a request for an exemption to the Noise By-Law for 337 Lake Range Drive, Point Clark from 11:00 p.m. Saturday, September 24, 2022 to 1:00 a.m. on Sunday, September 25, 2022 for a private wedding ceremony and reception with a band.

The Township has also received a noise exemption request from the Ripley Agriculture Society to have a fireworks display at dusk on Saturday, September 24th as part of the Ripley Fall Fair.

Discussion:

These requests were circulated to Township staff. Staff recommends approval of the exemption requests for these events subject to final approval of the fireworks display by the Fire Chief and will encourage the applicants to notify their neighbours in close proximity of the events.

The O.P.P and Township of Huron-Kinloss By-Law Enforcement Officer will both be notified of the events.
